Water Conservation

One of the first things that we have noticed is that some of our older style taps are using a lot of water, some of them up to and above 30 litres every minute! Most showers dont use this much water, so you certainly dont need to have the tap on full to wash your hands!

Did you know that we spend over €800,000 a year on water for CUH? Water used in hospitals and other healthcare facilities comprises almost 10% of the total water use in commercial and institutional facilities in the world. If you have leaking water fixtures in your area - report them! If you have taps that are so powerful that they fill the sink in seconds or wet the floor - don't turn them up full!
